FIELD REPORT FOR AUGUST 2013.

MAMBA TEAM DES-NARING UNIT

After a short break of 15 days the desnaring target for this month was restricted to Umani spring where there are a lot of wildlife species. In other areas no illegal activities were found. The team managed to patrol along forest boundary and found that there are a lot of elephants in the forest. Lots of wildlife find their way to Umani springs area because of its safety and the abundance of food.

Most of the water holes around Umani have dried up; this is because of the scorching sun that has been experienced in the recent past. During our patrol at Umani area the team saw a leopard, and a bushbuck it had killed. There are also lots of big pythons around Umani area. The team shall keep a close eye around the boundary and keep the daily patrol at Umani area. Mamba team is constantly putting pressure on the hotspots to ensure maximum safety of wildlife.
